

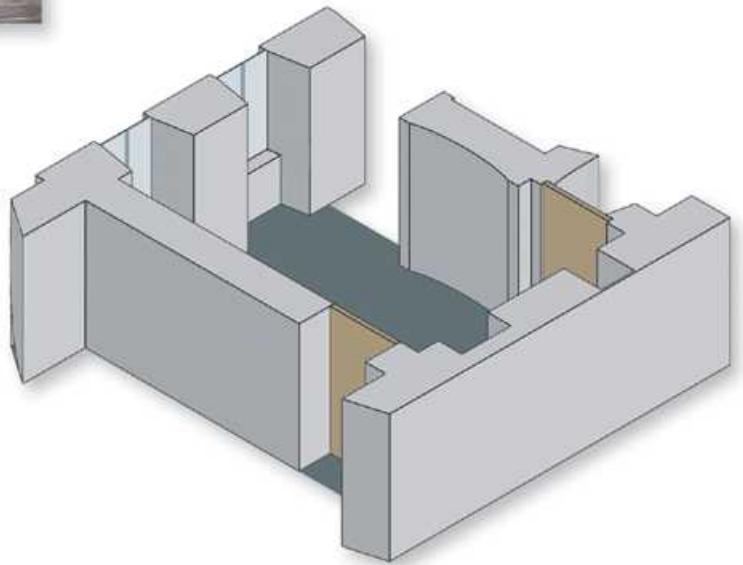
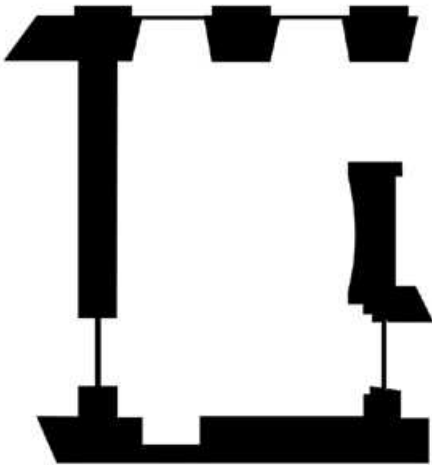
## Festival Cellar



The festival cellar is the centre of the Stavelot Holiday Theatre Festival, which sets up its restaurant and its bar there every year. An old chimneypiece, a C19th Empire-style stove and 2 C17th ornamental basins give this area a truly genuine style. The large windows looking onto the rear of the building mean that meetings can be held in a pleasant setting.
