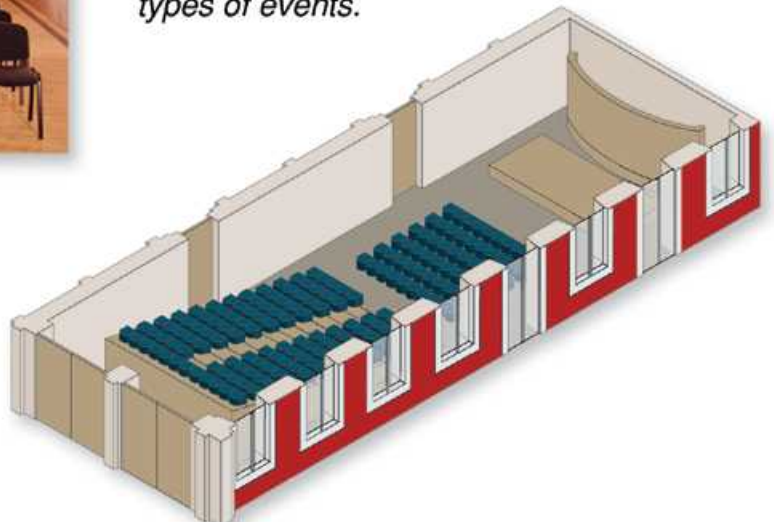


François Prume Hall

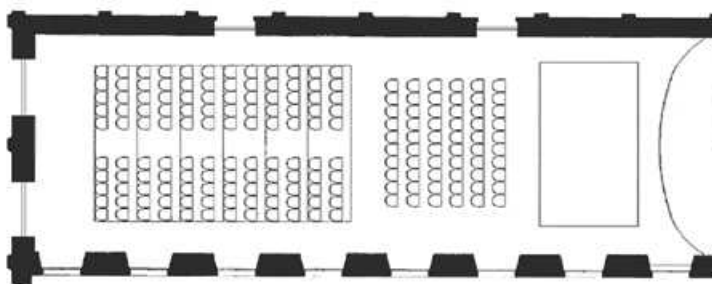


François Prume, a native of Stavelot, was an internationally renowned C19th violinist. This is vast area with a vaulted ceiling, which can be adapted to form a large variety of different layouts. A stage and tiers of seats can be arranged in the hall while direct access to the terrace and to the garden means that it is possible to organise all types of events.













Possible activities

Concerts, theatre, seminars, cocktail parties, meals, press conferences, product launch parties, private dances ...



Specific features

- Removable tiers of seats (122 seats).
- 2 possible acoustic configurations.
- Possibility of blacking out the windows.
- 2 trapdoors for stage management.
- Ceiling hooking system.
- Possibilities for combining arrangements with the east terrace, the cloister garden and the cloister.
- Accessible to the disabled.
- Floor : wooden flooring.
- Walls : wainscoting (2 m).
- Heating : floor grilles.
- Lighting : natural light

- Electricity : 20 x 220-V sockets
1 x 380-V, 125-A plugs
24 x "EC" 16-A sockets
